

Work Integration – Cross-Sector Partnerships

Setting/ What & Where?

- Disadvantaged persons or long-term unemployed people
- Cross-sector partnerships (CSP):
 - partners from **more than one sector**;
 - each sector must **invest their resources** into the partnership;
 - must **be formalized** to some degree.
- Desired outcome: effective integration into the labour market that goes beyond single actor capacity.
- Countries: Spain, Czech Republic, France, Germany
- Time horizon: 2005 - 2015

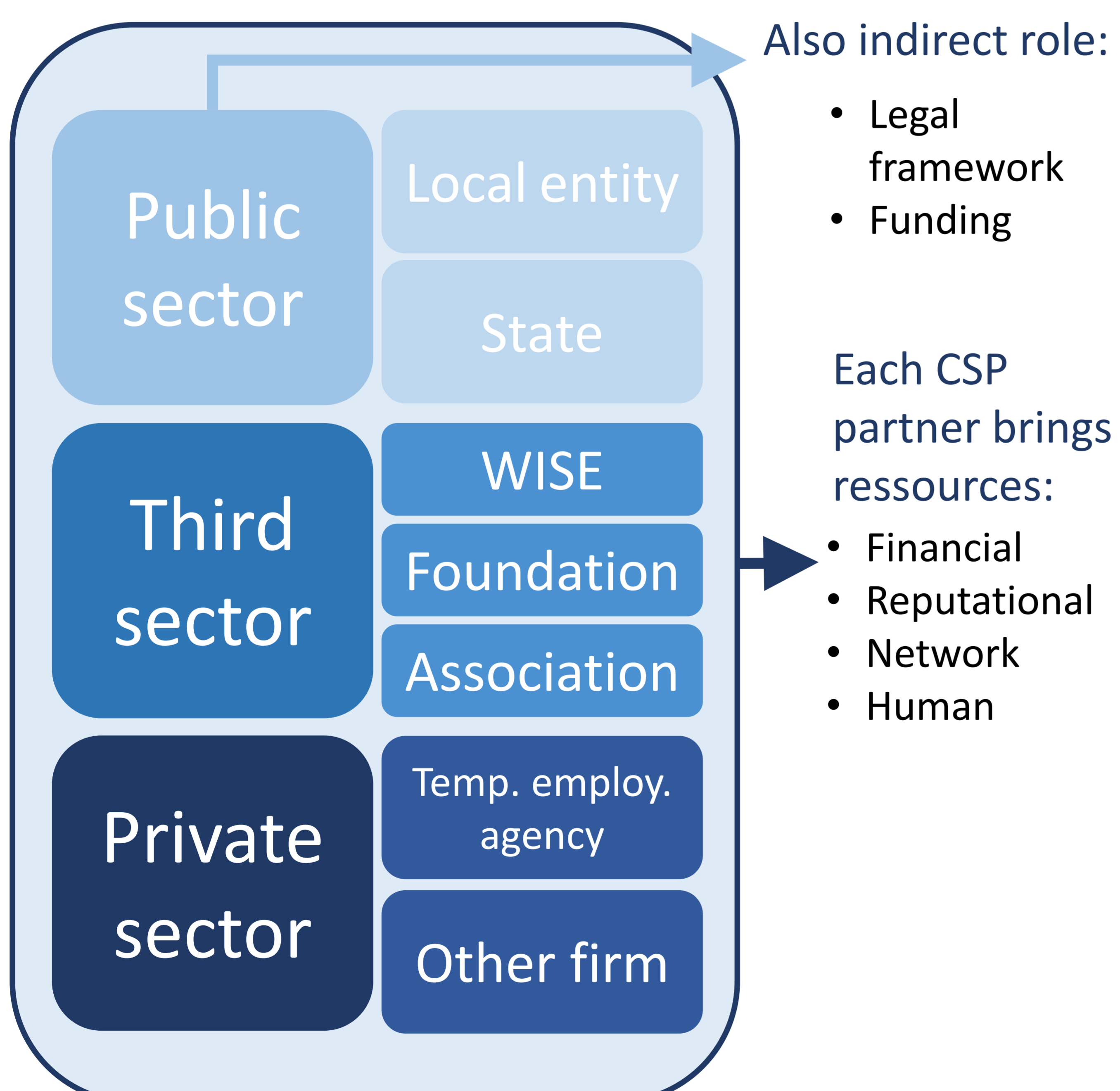

Organizational traits

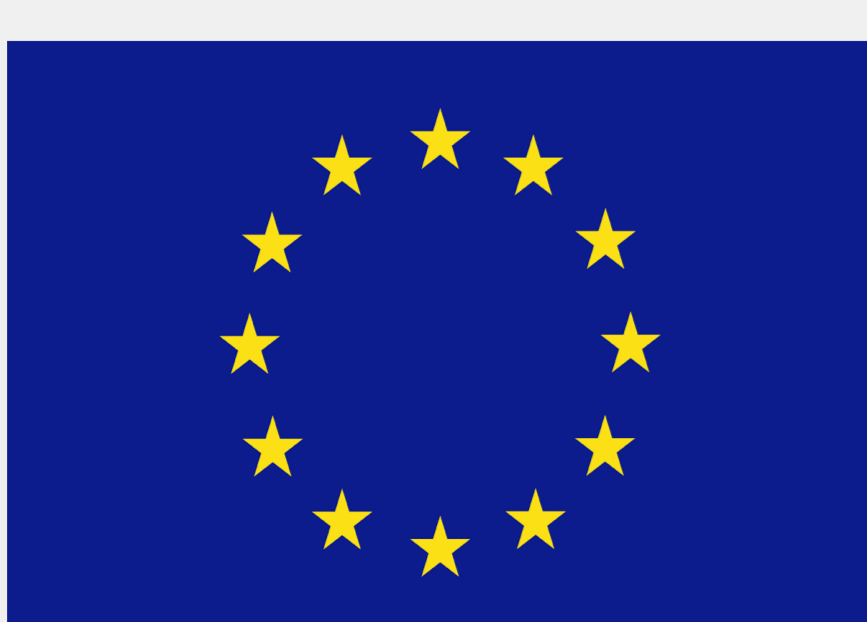
- High diversity of organisational traits
